We are a Peanut Free Zone

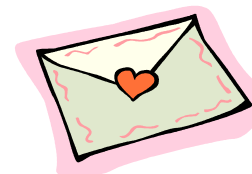
Thank you for continuing to respect the preschool's peanut free policy by not sending along any food to preschool with your child, especially with the Valentine's Day holiday approaching.
